Head Start & Early Head Start



IN HOME services:

- ◆ Any eligible family in our 3 1/2 counties
- ◆ A weekly 90 minute visit
- ◆ Activities designed for YOUR child
- ◆ Events for you & your child to meet other families held twice a month
- ◆ Parenting information & support
- ◆ Screening & information on healthy child development
- ◆ Services for 0-3 year olds are held YEAR ROUND

Early Head Start also supported by funds from:



HEAD START



Any family may apply for this State and Federally funded program,

but priority is given to those with limited income and children with special needs, including disabilities.



CLASSROOM or CENTER services:

- ∞ Bagley—older 3 year olds and all 4 year olds in a 4 day a week, full day program
- ∞ Thief River Falls —older 3 year olds and all 4 year olds in a 4 day a week, full day program
- ∞ McIntosh at The Clubhouse—3 year olds in a 5 day a week, 1/2 day program
- ∞ All play-based classes
- ∞ Activities designed for YOUR child
- ∞ Events for you & your child to meet other families held 4 times a year
- ∞ A family advocate will visit your family 6 times per year
- ∞ Meals provided
- ∞ Parenting information & support
- ∞ Screening & information on healthy child development

CLASSROOM or Combination services:

- 2 or more full days of classes for 4 year olds
- Head Start shares a classroom with School Readiness at the public schools in Fosston, Oklee & Win-E-Mac
- Teacher visit to your home twice a month
- Activities designed for YOUR child
- Events for you & your child to meet other families held 4 times a year
- Parenting information & support
- Screening & information on healthy child development
- Families can request transportation through the school district
